

**candlemas—February 2nd**

Thanks to Pope Sergius I (687-701), on February 2 we celebrate the Presentation of the Lord. On this day we also commemorate the Purification of Mary, who complied with the Jewish law (Leviticus 12:1). The law indicated that a mother should be purified forty days after giving birth to a boy child. Since the eleventh century the Purification of Mary and the Presentation of the Lord have been celebrated with the blessing of all the candles and candlesticks that are going to be used during the year. This is done with the hope that there will never be a lack of light, either material or spiritual, in the houses of the faithful. The root of the word candlemas is the Latin verb *candere* ("to shine") and from which also come the words candelabra and candlestick. This feast of candles recalls that Christians can, like Simon and the prophetess Anna in the temple, say that they also have seen salvation: Jesus the true Light who shines in the arms of Mary (Luke 2:25-38).

**A Tour of Salvation History**  
**February 15 — April 19, 2023**

The Wednesday Morning Bible Study group will be doing an 8-part study that gives a “big picture” overview of salvation history. This study from Ascension Press focuses on 14 narrative books of the Bible that tell the complete story from Adam and Eve to Christ and the Church. Presenter Jeff Cavins created a unique color-coded *Bible Timeline* Chart which divides the Bible into 12 time periods and arranges the key people, places, and events of the Bible in chronological order. This study, “Unlocking the Mystery of the Bible,” shows how the biblical narrative forms the foundation of our Catholic faith and how we fit into God’s plan.

This study consists of 8 sessions. It begins on Wednesday, February 15 and ends on Wednesday, April 19 (no class Ash Wednesday or Holy Week). The group will meet from 9:30-11:15 am in the Fr. Jim Cormack, cm Parish Center. Suggested Materials Fee is \$32. A partial scholarship is available.

Bible Study combines personal Bible reading and study with small-group discussion, lecture, and prayer in an informal setting. All are invited to attend; no previous bible study experience is necessary. We hope you will join us!

In addition, in a survey, an overwhelming majority of the parents of our school community expressed their willingness to help cover the salary with a significant increase in tuition.

Our children are our future. We want to continue what has been built here, so the parish has made a commitment to increase our subsidy of the school to help offset the impact of inflation.

Like you, we have been shocked at the higher prices for many common expenses. And like many of you, we are trying to be good stewards of our resources. Unfortunately, it has been necessary to spend from reserve funds to meet our expenses for the past few years.

# FAITH AND JUSTICE

## Will We Choose to Intersect with Others or Live Parallel Lives?

Jesus did not stop teaching when the Pharisees felt angry or guilty. His parables like the Good Samaritan and the Sower of the Seed taught His listeners how to love. We hear in Scripture how many walked away unwilling or unable to accept the connection between His words and their own lives.

*"We are still a nation with too many strangers. Our lives—when they do not intersect in open hostility—still seem to pass as parallel lines often at great distance from each other,"*  
(Cardinal Wilton Gregory at a Washington, D.C. Jan. 15 Mass honoring the legacy of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.)

There is a movement to legislate curriculum in schools—not to prevent the teaching of the past—but to prevent any connection to those living in the present. The argument that teaching the history of our nation oppresses whites because it creates guilt perpetuates whites and Blacks living along those parallel lines where we cannot meet, much less work together for justice. This proposed bill prevents our youth and their families from developing a relationship with Blacks—both with individuals and the community of Blacks in our city, county, and nation. If we can get past an initial response of "But I didn't cause this," we may grasp an opportunity to intersect with Blacks in our history and in our present—not as victims nor as heroes, but as God's people wanting to build relationships with those whose ancestors have endured the harshness of slavery, Jim Crow laws, lynching, segregation, etc. Studying the past promotes empathy and compassion for many who still struggle after generations of trauma. The least we can do is listen, learn, and strive to know others.

*"We are still discovering, and frequently with great surprise, that we are a diverse people and that diversity, far from being a threat, can be and ought to be received as a blessing"*  
(Cardinal Wilton Gregory. Jan. 15, 2023).

What can we do to intersect with Blacks?

- Use opportunities to connect the past with the present in order to build relationships with non-whites.
- Resist the urge to feel like a victim and instead frame these learning opportunities as blessings that can lead to relationship-building.

## ONLINE GIVING PLATFORM INSTRUCTIONS:

This will bring you to the main screen with the Online Giving Funds listed.

**If you do not wish to create an account and want to just make a quick-give gift**, you can click on the "Give Now" button underneath the name of the fund you wish to donate to. A new screen will appear in order to configure the gift. After you enter the gift amount, gift type and date, you will click on continue. **IMPORTANT:** The default gift type is "recurring", so if you only want a one-time gift, click on the drop down arrow next to the word recurring and select one-time. A new screen will appear requesting your personal and payment information. At the bottom of the screen, you can "Create an Account" or "Give Gift as a Guest".

**If you are already an Online Giving User**, you will click on "Sign In/Create an Account" in the purple bar on the top right hand side of the screen. This will take you to the login screen where you can enter your email address and password. UserID's are no longer used; they have been replaced with your email address. If you have forgotten your password, click on the link "Forgot Password" and enter your email address. Instructions will be sent to you to reset your password. Once you log into your account, your upcoming gifts and transaction history will appear. If you wish to change an upcoming gift, click on the three dots next to the dollar amount. You will have the option to "edit", "pause gift" or "cancel gift". Follow the prompts to complete any of these tasks. The system is user friendly.
