

Advent Challenge—Counter Hate Speech

“When the days were completed for their purification, according to the law of Moses, they took him up to Jerusalem to present Him to the Lord, just as it is written in the law of the Lord”
 (Luke 2:22-23).

Jesus was Jewish. Like Jesus we have Jewish roots.



When people in our lives drift purposefully or lazily into hate speech, do I respond with silence? Do I feel uncomfortable but just change the subject? Do I excuse and eventually exonerate the behavior? Do I let fear prevent me from speaking up for people who are Jewish, Asian, Hispanic, Muslim, or for any group maligned in public discourse, in our social circles, in our church parking lots?

The United Nations defines hate speech as any kind of communication in speech, writing or behavior that attacks or uses discriminatory language about a person or a group on the basis of who they are—their religion, ethnicity, nationality, race, color, descent, gender or other identity factor. Hate speech can be interrupted.

Here is an Advent challenge to work toward hope, peace, joy, and love by countering hate speech.

Hate comments from relatives around the table or at a party can take me by surprise and make me feel like melting into the walls rather than getting involved. If I have a plan in place, I can call upon God and my Catholic faith to address hate in conversations.

- Make a serious effort to promote conversation and dialog. Firmly and calmly counter hate comments with—"Here is my experience... Then share a narrative about people, historical events, or facts affirming the human dignity of others.
- Stop supporting media outlets, individuals, and organizations that create, encourage, and perpetuate racist stereotypes and propose violence and anarchy as solutions.
- Appreciate the gift of cultural diversity. Participate in study groups, hold potlucks, embrace cross-cultural choirs, etc. to bring people together at the parish level.
- Put God in the conversation. Each of us is made in the image and likeness of God.
- Pray, fast, and ask for Mary's intercession and for God's help.

OUR FASCINATING FAITH—LAS POSADAS (DECEMBER 16–24)

Of the many Latin American traditions for the celebration of Advent and Christmas, the tradition of Las Posadas seems to be the best known. It originated in the last half of the eighteenth century when the boisterous Misas de Aguinaldo were no longer celebrated in Mexico. To replace these Masses, the laity decided to celebrate in their own homes by taking what they had seen dramatized in the churches: the journey of the Galilean immigrants, Joseph and Mary of Nazareth, when they were looking for an inn (posada) in Bethlehem of Judea. Like the "O Antiphons" of the official liturgy, these posadas were celebrated on nine consecutive nights.

The journey of Joseph and Mary from inn to inn sadly continues every day in the fearful and tired steps taken by so many immigrants in this country. Like the Holy Family, Latin American families look for hospitality with the hope of finding a new life for their sons and daughters. Unfortunately, many citizens of the United States behave like the people of Bethlehem, preferring to close their door in the face of the immigrants rather than welcoming them. Perhaps that is the reason that the tradition of Las Posadas has taken on so much importance among the Latinos in the United States. We know firsthand what Joseph and Mary experienced two thousand years ago. We have to ask ourselves: When will the human heart change? When will we open the doors of our heart to our immigrant Lord?

About MOScholars

MOScholars is Missouri's ESA- Empowerment Scholarship Account program. It provides state tax credits in exchange for contributions to non-profit Educational Assistance Organizations (EAOs). EAOs then use the contributions to award scholarships to Missouri students living in low-income households or those on Individualized Education Programs. TTEF is Your Local EAO!

Who is Eligible To Donate?

- An individual subject to Missouri state income tax.

Betrothal of Mary and Joseph

Was Mary really an “unwed mother”? As Matthew makes clear in today’s Gospel, the answer is clearly no—Mary and Joseph were really “betrothed,” she was his wife, and Joseph was really contemplating divorce. Marriage customs were such that the last stage of the marriage was that the betrothed came together to live as husband and wife. The Annunciation and the Incarnation of Jesus take place *after* betrothal but *before* they lived together. What would you have done if you were Joseph? (CCC 437, 488, 1846)

ONLINE GIVING PLATFORM INSTRUCTIONS:

At the end of 2020 our Online Giving provider implemented a new platform. Everything rolled over from the previous site and no changes were required of you, but the site now looks and acts a little different. You can access the new Online Giving site directly by going to: <https://www.osvhub.com/sclparish/funds> or by accessing the site through St. Catherine Laboure's website, www.sclparish.org, then clicking on the Online Giving Box with the green medallion and cross picture in it. This will bring you to the main screen with the Online Giving Funds listed.

If you do not wish to create an account and want to just make a quick-give gift, you can click on the "Give Now" button underneath the name of the fund you wish to donate to. A new screen will appear in order to configure the gift. After you enter the gift amount, gift type and date, you will click on continue. **IMPORTANT:** The default gift type is "recurring", so if you only want a one-time gift, click on the drop down arrow next to the word recurring and select one-time. A new screen will appear requesting your personal and payment information. At the bottom of the screen, you can "Create an Account" or "Give Gift as a Guest".

If you are already an Online Giving User, you will click on "Sign In/Create an Account" in the purple bar on the top right hand side of the screen. This will take you to the login screen where you can enter your email address and password. UserID's are no longer used; they have been replaced with your email address. If you have forgotten your password, click on the link "Forgot Password" and enter your email address. Instructions will be sent to you to reset your password. Once you log into your account, your upcoming gifts and transaction history will appear. If you wish to change an upcoming gift, click on the three dots next to the dollar amount. You will have the option to "edit", "pause gift" or "cancel gift". Follow the prompts to complete any of these tasks. The system is user friendly.
